

# Welcome Letter "Go Nuts with Mutts "XI"

## Arrival Information

**Friday, April 13th:**

**CAMPERS** (dry campers and partial hook-ups)

**1.** *If you arrive by 4:30 p.m.* go directly to the Fairgrounds Office to pay fees (\$35/night) and get your camping permit. (Located on Chance Ave., Gate #2) If you know that you will be arriving AFTER 4:30 p.m., please call ahead to Joanne at the fairgrounds office to pay by credit card. Her direct line is 559-650-3225. This will not reserve you a particular site (see #3 below) but makes it easier for fairground personnel to collect fees on late arrivals.

**2.** Once fees are paid, or if you arrive *after* 4:30 p.m. enter the Fairgrounds parking lot via Kings Canyon, 2 gates east of Chance Ave. Look for "Mutts in Motion" signage. (If for some reason you are a late arrival and haven't paid fees by credit card, the fairgrounds personnel will collect your fees on Saturday.)

**3.** The RV spaces around the Industry and Commerce (I.C.) Bldg. are partial hookups of electrical and a few water hookups-(if you utilize the water, please make sure connections are tight so as not to waste water). All sites are technically first come first serve—however we will make every effort to accommodate all rigs and keep clubs together to the best of our ability. Most of the clubs will be in the same spots as last year – we have a good plan drawn out thanks to all the clubs that have already contacted our Camp Coordinators! If you haven't done so yet, please have one contact person from your club contact Carla ([carla@muttsinmotion.com](mailto:carla@muttsinmotion.com)) or Maria ([theskiwizard@gmail.com](mailto:theskiwizard@gmail.com)) with the following information:

a) Contact Person and Club Name b) Number and Type of Rig(s) (Trailer, Van, RV, etc.) c) Length of Rig(s) and d) Date and approx. Time you will be arriving. This will help us determine parking some of the bigger rigs and getting everyone in safely and efficiently. Also if you have any physical disability requirements, please let us know that too. The Fresno Fairgrounds may change their policies at any time with respect to areas available to us for RV parking.

**4.** Dry Camping: In the parking lot adjacent to the Industry Commerce Bldg., enter on Kings Canyon. Fees for dry camping or partial hookups are the same-- \$35.00/night.

**5. Full Hookups:** If you desire full hookups, you can make a reservation in the fairgrounds campground, which is a ¼ mile away or there are a few spots on pavement across the parking lot and a longer walk to/from the flyball venue.

*Bring your RV extension cords so we can utilize all available plugs.*

***Teams wishing to set up their crates on Friday can do so between the hours of 3 p.m. – 7 p.m and is first come first serve.*** Please be courteous and not take up more space than your team needs. Contact our "Crating and Camp Coordinators", Carla Aguirre at (559)779-6667 or Maria Fermoile at (559)978-4834 for any questions or concerns. Our coordinators will be available beginning Thursday afternoon.

### **It's BACK – Friday Night "Rent a Ring" Racing!**

Your team can rent the ring for \$20 for 10 minutes! You may use the ring for whatever your dog/s need to practice. There won't be start lights, but the display clock will count down your time.

Signups have already begun through our facebook event page but check in at 3:30 p.m. Friday to see if there are still any open slots. Ring time will start promptly at 4:00p.m. and run until 7:00p.m.

### **Unloading/Parking:**

**Saturday and Sunday, April 14th/15th:** Enter venue parking lot via Kings Canyon (2 gates east of Chance) beginning at 6:00 a.m. each morning. You will be able to park and unload directly outside the Industry and Commerce Bldg. The facility and parking lot will have 24 hour security and be locked by 9 p.m. each evening.

### **Lodging**

**Motel Reservations:** If you haven't made your reservations, go to our website for the complete list of motels and information about reservations to camp at the fairgrounds.

### **Directions to Fairgrounds/Industry and Commerce Bldg.**

**From the South:** North on 99, to Hwy 41 North, to Hwy 180 East, Kings Canyon. As you approach the Hwy 168 turnoff, (stay straight on Hwy 180) immediately take the Cedar Avenue exit #60B. At signal turn left (South) on Cedar. At the 4th stoplight, turn left (East) on Ventura, which immediately becomes Kings Canyon. Continue past Chance Ave. and turn right into the 2<sup>nd</sup> gate leading to the venue parking lot.

**From the North:** South on 99, exit Hwy 180 East, Kings Canyon. As you approach the Hwy 168 turnoff, (stay straight on Hwy 180)

immediately take the Cedar Avenue exit #60B. At signal turn left (South) on Cedar. At the 4th stoplight, turn left (East) on Ventura, which immediately becomes Kings Canyon. Continue past Chance Ave. and turn right into the 2<sup>nd</sup> gate leading to the venue parking lot.

**From the West:** Take Ventura and head east. As you cross Cedar, Ventura becomes Kings Canyon. Continue past Chance Ave. and turn right into the 2<sup>nd</sup> gate leading to the venue parking lot.

**From the East:** Take Kings Canyon and head west. After passing Maple, fairgrounds will be on your left. Make a U Turn and turn right into the 2<sup>nd</sup> gate leading to the venue parking lot.

**Lunch:** Plan on bringing your own lunch as the fairgrounds currently doesn't have plans to set up a food booth this year. There are several restaurants and fast food restaurants nearby.
